Get Rebates for Installing Qualified Natural Gas Appliances

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Energy Conservation Program is to provide an incentive for builders to install natural gas appliances in residential dwellings. Rebates will be applied to customer accounts when a qualified natural gas appliance is installed in new residential housing. Natural gas is the cleanest and most efficient use of our natural resources. The program is designed to reduce harmful pollution caused by costly electrical generation. By switching to clean burning natural gas appliances you can reduce at least a rhino's worth (3,000 pounds) of CO₂ from the atmosphere every year and save money too!

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

York County Natural Gas Authority (YCNGA) will provide rebates (see schedule below) to builders when program conditions are met. Rebates will be credited against balances on any current or previous account. All credits will be applied to the builders account and not to a subcontractor account.

Builders may purchase appliances from YCNGA or another appliance dealer. If the appliance is purchased from YCNGA, the rebate will be applied against the purchase price.

PROGRAM CONDITIONS

- One rebate per appliance
- New appliances only (used appliances do not qualify)
- Appliances must be CSA certified
- Installation of appliances must be verified by a YCNGA employee

BUILDER COMMITMENT

- Complete a separate Rebate Request Form for each individual dwelling
- Provide access to the dwelling for verification of installation

APPLIANCE REBATE SCHEDULE

Builders who install qualified natural gas appliances in new residential dwellings are eligible for rebates under YCNGA's Energy Conservation Program (ECP) as follows:
